 - Investment tax allowance for the purchase of green technology equipment.
 - Income tax exemption for green technology services companies.
- This was further announced in the 2014 National Budget. GreenTech Malaysia is given the mandate to verify or evaluate the application according to the eligible tax incentive.
- The purpose of this incentive is to strengthen the development of green technology through Green Investment Tax Allowances (GITA) for the purchase of green technology equipment/ assets and Green Income Tax Exemption (GITE) for green technology service providers.

GREEN TECHNOLOGY TAX INCENTIVES

• Investment Tax Allowance (ITA) of 100% of qualifying capital expenditure incurred on a green technology project from the year of assessment 2013 (date on which the first qualifying capital expenditure incurred is not earlier than 25 October 2013) until the year of assessment 2020. The allowance can be offset against 70% of statutory income in the year of assessment. Unutilised allowances can be carried forward until they are fully absorbed.
