JOB SUMMARY:

The Team Trainer will be responsible for training new operators, as well as, the retraining of current operators. The primary objective of the Team trainer will be to ensure new team members have all of the skills and training necessary to operate our Carlo Salvi parts former. In general, this will include understanding the safe operating of the equipment, quality requirements of the parts manufactured, proper measuring techniques, and all other production aspects of the machine. It also includes an understanding of how to manufacturing the range of SPR's that we make at Henrob.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Train new team members on work instructions and forms per process control plan
- Train all newly hired operators on SPC software and measuring techniques and equipment
- Can read and understand steel-labels and lot-control tags
- Ability to use and analyze micrometers, calipers and all other measuring devices
- Teach and apply the use of cold forming principles
- Attend any and all continuous trainings and apply to process
- Identify and train operators on the difference in wire size
- Grip and operate various hand tools including, electric grinder, bolt cutters, and wrenches
- Assist operators with technical machine issues throughout the day
- Work with Henrob Group companies on technical issues
- Troubleshoot quality issues during production
- Transition to production operations if no new trainees are in the plant
- Assist leader in production operations as required
- Participate in the interviewing of new production operators
- Follow 5-S principles
- Safe operation of powered industrial trucks

The Trainer will train new operators, transfers to the department, and the retraining of current operators. The Team Trainer helps ensure operators are trained to the highest standards and able to contribute to the safe, efficient, and accurate production of rivets.

- Provide guidance to operators to ensure they follow all safety guidelines.
- Use training material and knowledge to demonstrate how to operate collation machines, perform machine changeovers, and inspect for quality and conformance to specifications.
- Provide ongoing support and constructive daily feedback to operators to help them develop the skills required to be successful in the role.
- Recognize when an employee is having difficulty completing tasks and be able to adjust training methods to different learning styles.
- Collaborate with other members of the production team to ensure that all operators are trained to the highest standards and can contribute to the success of the company.
- Train team members on work instructions, forms per process control plan and work instructions.
- Transition to production operations with an acceptable level of output depending on the training needs required.
- Address/escalate performance concerns.
- Assist Team Leader in production operations as required.
- Help interview job applicants and make hiring recommendations.
- Follow and train on 5-S principles, shift changeover and all operating procedures in the work zone.
